## ANY SOLID COLOUR

SP P 1 (1)Lockwoods Eddeswarren Eclipse 8 month black b presented in good coat, strong chunky muzzle and long low set ears, compact with a good spring of rib of age, level topline and shapely quarters, just needs to settle on the move but a happy exhibit with a lovely temperament.

SP N (4,1) 1 Rofes Villispaniol Gold Flash A well presented gold d and the best mover in the class, head is a little heavy for my preference and neck could be cleaner, stands on good legs and feet with correct topline and croup, moved out soundly 2 Hansens Rizi Bizi Maya chocolate girl not in her best coat but with a reasonable all over shape and lovely bone, she doesn't need to be carrying any more weight on her, very sound on the move3 Davies Luciena Divine Peace

SP PG (2,1) 1 Rofes Villaspaniol Sunny Delight gold d whose head could be a tad stronger but he has a soft kind expression and long low set ears, pleasing neck with a good lay of shoulder and a firm topline held on the move. A sound and happy lad with an ever wagging tail.

SP N (3,1) 1 Hansens Helluin Baroque Pearl a very pretty girl whose head appealed, she has well boned forelegs and good feet, sufficient forechest and depth of chest but could have slightly more hind angulation, once settled she moved out well with good drive 2 Biggs Patagoco Persimmon 4yr roan b, overall quite a nicely balanced exhibit, lovely dark eye and correct bite, strong neck and standing straight in front on padded feet, better in rear angulation than the winner but needs to firm in topline.

SP PG This was a very good class (11,3) 1 Kotanen Triplet Queen Of Queens (Imp Fin) A smart blue b with good bone and substance all through, pleasing head with a lovely dark eye exuding a soft expression, elegant neck into well laid shoulders, cobby in outline and a strong firm topline, a super mover displaying good driving action and covering the ground with ease keeping her beautiful shape 2 Green and Brains Cachel Pop The Question To Meleronas JW a very pretty b with a super expression, lovely neck and a good lay of shoulder, well developed in forechest and deep through the chest. Firm and strong in topline and loin, another sound mover, today I just preferred the neck and shoulders of the winner 3 Drivers Annilann Miss Magiscstar At Beckaby JW

SP O (1) 1 Hutton- Baber Esqueen Following Star At Babtonkelpie (Imp Pol) A well presented 12 mth b, lovely head shape with good chiselling and clear dark eyes, pleasing neck and lay of shoulders, compact in body with well angulated quarters, a very sound moving girl with good drive. Will be interesting to see how she matures as there is a lot to like about her.

V (9,3) 1 and RBIS, BVIS Bavin and Austins Rojoys Chase the Dream JW Sh. CM a beautiful 8 yr blue in fabulous condition, balanced and proportionate with a cobby body and good bone, lovely head with feminine traits and dark eye, moderate length of neck leading cleanly into a good lay of shoulder, straight forelegs to well padded feet, good depth of chest and plenty of heartroom, well sprung ribs and a strong firm topline retained on the move, shapely muscled hindquarters with strong hocks, such a sound and easy mover 2 Cassidys Manchela Hugo Boss JW. Sh CM another super veteran and one I have done well for previously, still in great shape and carrying a good topline both stacked and on the move however today he could not match the winners rear drive 3 Edginton Uxendel Daydream Of Ware

MP (2,1) 1 and BMP Bindza Laurellakes Dream Chaser 7mth gold d with lovely bone and feet and who makes a pleasing shape on the stack, still carrying plenty of puppy coat but does not detract from the overall appeal and he has a super topline for such a baby. He just needs to gather himself on the move as his action was a little difficult to assess today.

PD (2,1) 1 and BPIS Bindzas Laurellakes Dream Machine 9mth b/t id n beautiful coat and condition, head still needs to develop on and he has a bit of a roman nose going on which hopefully might level out as he matures, full dark eye with a soft expression and well feathered ears, enough neck length with sufficient lay of shoulder and well bent stifles. A happy confident mover and in the challenge for BP, this is what won him through.

PB (5,2) 1 Whites Abbzig Love Me Do At Merrysprings I really liked the head and outline of this 10mth roan, she was presented in super coat and is nicely compact with enough forechest and heart room for her age although I would have liked a little more spring of rib, the most forward moving of the class and well handled to get the best from her. 2 Kidds Laurellakes Dream Come True with Freestone black b with a lovely head, clear eye and soft kind expression, stands on well boned forelegs and well padded feet, compact enough with a good spring of rib just not as forward on the move as the winner and I would have liked to feel better muscle on her quarters. 3 Eddeswarren Eclipse

JB (6,3) 1 Villaspaniol Gold Flash (see SP N) 2 Eddeswarren Eclipse (see SP P)3 Helluin Baroque Pearl.

T (5,3) 1 Esqueen Following Star At Babtonkelpie (Imp Pol) (See SP O) 2 Luciena Divine Peace 2oth b/t a very pretty girl with a lovely dark eye and good nose pigment but quite immature compared to the winner, firm enough in topline with sufficient hind angulation but needs a little more spring of rib and to develop in chest and forechest

G (61) 1 and BIS Cassidys Manchela Speechless At Cassoz JW this striking blue is quite an elegant boy but defiantly all male! He is so well balanced on the stack with a moderate length of neck which is well muscled, well laid shoulders, compact in body with a good spring of rib and strong broad loin, well rounded muscular rear with short strong hocks, sound and accurate with good drive. showman. 2 Drivers Brackenjack Bit Of Allsorts At Beckaby, a handsome male and another who is quite pleasing on the stack, slightly longer cast than the winner but standing on well boned forelegs and good feet with a deep brisket and firm topline, carries himself well around the ring 3 Lundins Omennes Star Lord

Sp Beg (7,3) 1 Triplet Queen Of Queens (Imp Fin) (See SP PG) 2 Cachel Pop The Question To Meleronas JW (See SP PG) 3 Esqueen Following Star At Babtonkelpie (Imp Pol)

OD (3) 1 Drivers Annilann Mister Spangles At Beckaby JW well balanced and compact this roan boy has much to like about him, chiselled head with distinct stop and bright intelligent eyes, strong neck of moderate length, deep brisket and well developed in forechest, short strong loin and well bent stifles with short hocks and correct tailset, moved out happily displaying good drive. Close up for top honours. 2 Line Sam Appealing Partner IMP SWE slightly bigger and a tad longer than the winner, very nice head proportions and a lovely eye and expression, strong neck and well ribbed body, I would have liked a little more forechest but he has good depth to his brisket and broad muscled quarters, sound and free on the move 3 CH Line Sam Gaze For hugs

OB 4 (4) 1 Rojoys Chase the Dream JW Sh. CM (See V) 2 Daniels Starbourne Calibrachoa 6yr blue with an attractive head and expression, slightly smaller all over than the winner but everything is in its place, and she was presented in fit muscled condition, enough length to foreleg and compact feet with a firm topline to correctly set tail, I would have liked little more of her all over but she is very sound and true on the move which gained her the placing tody.3 Helluin Baroque Pearl
